


Via Seating Lifecycle Guide

Do you have a Via Seating chair that you no longer need? Before discarding your chair, take a look at our Product Lifecycle Guide! This guide will help you evaluate your chair and determine the next steps in its product lifecycle.

Inspect Your Chair!

- Check the frame, j-bar, legs, and base
 - o Are there any signs of damage?
 - o Does the chair feel unstable?
- Check the upholstery & mesh
 - o Are there any stains, tears, or signs of excessive wear?
- Check the arms
 - o Are there any signs of damage?
 - o Are adjustable arms stuck or no longer fully adjustable?
- Check the control & gaslift
 - o Do the levers no longer function?
 - o Is the seat height no longer adjustable?
- Check the casters or glides
 - o Are the casters stuck or difficult to move?
 - o Are the glides missing parts?




Donate Your Chair!
